



Henry Mayo Newhall Hospital's New Patient Tower

This beautiful six-story tower (with one story underground) was built to meet the growing healthcare needs of the Santa Clarita Valley.

- Floors three through five include 90 private patient rooms, with private bathrooms and ample space for patients, family and staff.
- New 29-bed Center for Women and Newborns features 22 antepartum/postpartum beds and seven labor and delivery beds; non-clinical furnishings for calmer feeling; more patient privacy; baby sinks for washing and care of newborn babies; and two dedicated OB surgical suites.
- Permanent rooftop helipad with direct access to the Emergency Department.
- New, expanded nutritional services and cafeteria with hotel-quality kitchen; indoor and outdoor dining areas; physicians dining area; central atrium dining garden that admits light to indoor dining area, servery and corridor.
- Expanded Laboratory Department to facilitate faster results for urgent diagnoses.
- Expanded Materials Management Department to ensure improved delivery time of medical supplies.
- "We Care A Latte" coffee kiosk in the tower lobby.
